**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF TRANSIT ASSET
MANAGEMENT PLAN. (TAM Plan)**

WHEREAS, 49 CFR Part 625, the FTA Transit Asset Management Rule, which became effective on October 1, 2016, requires transit operators to develop and adopt a Transit Asset Management Plan that addresses State of Good Repair for rolling stock, infrastructure, equipment, and facilities; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) issued a final rule on transit asset management to establish a system to monitor and manage public transportation assets to improve safety and increase reliability and performance, under which providers of public transportation receiving federal funds were required to set their initial asset management targets by January 1, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ojai has the responsibility under the provisions of the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act for developing and carrying out a continuing, cooperative and comprehensive transportation planning process.

WHEREAS, the Transit Department of the City of Ojai had developed a TAM Plan which outlines capital asset inventory, condition assessments, investment prioritization, system condition changes, and performance targets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the City Council of the City of Ojai does hereby endorse and adopt the Transit Asset Management Plan and its targets as outlined in the attached materials; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Transit Operations Supervisor and City Mechanic are authorized to provide additional information as the Department may require, in connection with the application for the Section 5311 projects as it applies to the TAM plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Public Works is authorized to submit and approve requests for reimbursement of funds from the Department for the Section 5311 projects as it pertains to the TAM plan.
