

**CITY OF OJAI  
RESOLUTION NO. 14-20**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA SUBMITTING TO QUALIFIED ELECTORS THE  
QUESTIONS RELATING TO MAKING THE OFFICE OF MAYOR AN ELECTED POSITION**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has ordered a Municipal Election to be held on Tuesday, November 4, 2014 as set forth in Resolution No 14-18; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Ojai also desires to submit to the qualified electors of said City at said election the questions relating to making the office of Mayor an elected position and whether or not the term of Mayor should be four (4) or two (2) years.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, THAT THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the laws of the State of California relating to General Law Cities within said State, there shall be, and there is hereby called and ordered, held in the City of Ojai, County of Ventura, State of California, on Tuesday, the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2014, a regular general municipal election of the qualified electors of said City.

Section 2. That said City Council, pursuant to its right and authority so to do, does hereby determine that there shall be and there is hereby ordered submitted to the qualified electors of said City at said regular general municipal election the following questions, to wit:

“Shall the electors elect a mayor and four city councilmembers?”

“Shall the term of office of mayor be two years?”

“Shall the term of office of mayor be four years?”

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
