RESOLUTION NO. 14-21**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA,  
SETTING PRIORITIES FOR FILING (A) WRITTEN ARGUMENT(S) REGARDING A CITY  
MEASURE AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO PREPARE AN IMPARTIAL  
ANALYSIS**

**WHEREAS**, a General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Ojai, California, on November 4, 2014, at which there will be submitted to the voters the following measure:

“Shall the electors elect a mayor and four city councilmembers?”

“Shall the term of office of mayor be two years?”

“Shall the term of office of mayor be four years?”

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That the City Council authorizes NONE of its members of the City Council to file a written argument In Favor of or Against City measure. Qualified Voters may submit arguments. In the event more than one argument is submitted, the City Clerk will decide which argument for or against will be published. Arguments may be changed or withdrawn until and including the date fixed by the City Clerk after which no arguments for or against the City measure may be submitted to the City Clerk. The fixed dates shall be July 22 through July 30, 2014.

Section 2. That the city council directs the City Clerk to transmit a copy of the measure to the city attorney. The city attorney shall prepare an impartial analysis of the measure not exceeding 500 words showing the effect of the measure on the existing law and the operation of the measure. If the measure affects the organization or salaries of the office of the city attorney, the city clerk shall prepare the impartial analysis. The analysis shall include a statement indicating whether the measure was placed on the ballot by a petition signed by the requisite number of voters or by the governing body of the city. In the event the entire text of the measure is not printed on the ballot, not in the voter information portion of the sample ballot, “there shall be printed immediately below the impartial analysis, in no less than 10-point type, the following: The above statement is an impartial analysis of Measure \_\_\_\_\_. If you desire a copy of the measure, please call the election official’s office at 805-646-5581 and a copy will be mailed at no cost to you. The impartial analysis shall be filed by the date set by the City Clerk which shall be July 1, 2014.

Section 3. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


