RESOLUTION NO. 16-44**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA,  
REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF VENTURA TO  
CONSOLIDATE A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON  
NOVEMBER 8, 2016**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of the laws relating to general law cities in the State of California, a General Municipal Election shall be held on Tuesday, November 8, 2016, for the election of Municipal Officers; and

**WHEREAS**, other elections may be held in whole or in part of the territory of the City and it is to the advantage of the City to consolidate pursuant to Elections Code Section 10400; and

**WHEREAS**, Elections Code Section 10242 provides that the governing board (City Council) shall determine the hours of opening and closing the polls; and

**WHEREAS**, Elections Code Section 10002 requires the City to reimburse the County in full for the services performed upon presentation of a bill to the City by the County elections official; and

**WHEREAS**, Elections Code Section 13307 requires that before the nominating period opens the governing body must determine whether a charge shall be levied against each candidate submitting a candidate's statement to be sent to the voters; and

**WHEREAS**, Elections Code Section 12101 requires the publication of a notice of the election once in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA,  
DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The General Municipal Election shall be held on Tuesday, the 8th day of November 2016. The purpose of the election is to elect: one (1) City Council seat, at-large, for a full term of four years; a Mayor, at-large, for a full term of two years; a City Clerk, at-large, for a full term of four years; and a City Treasurer, at-large, for a full term of four years.

Section 2. The City Council of Ojai hereby respectfully requests of the County of Ventura under Elections Code section 10403 and herein consents, to the consolidation of the election with other elections, which may be held on said day in whole or in part of the territory of the City, as provided in Elections Code Section 10400 and acknowledges that the election will be conducted as per Elections Code Section 10418.

- Section 3. The City hereby designates the hours the local polls are to be kept open shall be from 7:00AM to 8:00PM.
- Section 4. The City will reimburse the County for the actual cost incurred in conducting the General Municipal election upon receipt of a bill stating the amount due as determined by the elections official.
- Section 5. The City Council has determined that each Candidate will pay for the voluntary Candidate's Statement as set forth in Resolution No. 16-~~45~~.
- Section 6. The City Council of Ojai directs the City Clerk to publish the Notice of Election in the Ojai Valley News, which is a newspaper of general circulation that is regularly circulated in the City of Ojai.
- Section 7. The City Council of Ojai directs the City Clerk to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Registrar of Voters and the Board of Supervisors of County of Ventura.
- Section 8. The City Council of the City of Ojai, pursuant to the provision of the California Elections Code, hereby respectfully requests that the Ventura County Board of Supervisors direct the Ventura County Registrar to conduct all necessary services related to the Ojai General Municipal Election, and to bill the City for the cost of conducting the election. The City Manager is hereby authorized to reimburse Ventura County in full for such services actually performed upon presentation of a bill therefore from the County.
- Section 9. In the event two or more candidates receive an equal number of votes. The resolution of a tie vote will be by lot, pursuant to Section 15651 of the Elections Code of the State of California.
- Section 10. In all particulars not recited in this resolution, the election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding consolidated municipal elections.
- Section 11. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
- Section 12. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.


