Resolution No. 18-26**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA, STATING INTENT TO ORDER THE WORK AND LEVYING ASSESSMENTS NECESSARY FOR THE MAINTENANCE OF LANDSCAPING, LIGHTING, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE PLAZA MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 2 FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING JULY 1, 2018 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2019.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Ojai, California on January 23, 2018 adopted Resolution No. 18-04 in accordance with the provisions of the “Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972” of the State of California (the “Assessment Law”), requiring the City Engineer to make and file with the City Clerk a report in writing presenting certain matters relating to the continuation of a landscaping and lighting maintenance district known as the Plaza Maintenance Assessment District No. 2 (the “District”) in the City and to initiate proceedings to levy and collect assessments for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 in connection with the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Engineer filed the Engineer’s Report entitled Plaza Maintenance Assessment District Engineer’s Report dated April 24, 2018 (the “Report”) with the City Clerk; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-15 on April 24, 2018 approving the Report; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 18-16 on April 24, 2018 declaring its intention to levy and collect assessments in the District with a five percent increase from the amount of the assessment in Fiscal Year 2015-2016 as approved by the District’s property owners in June 2012; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to levy and collect assessments in the District with no increase from FY 2017-2018 and to order certain maintenance activities and certain utility payments and services and other public improvements to be maintained for a period beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019 as specifically outlined in the Report.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AND ORDER, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. That the foregoing recitals are all true and correct.

SECTION 2. That the City Council does hereby approve, confirm and adopt the diagram and assessments for the District as set forth in the Report. The amount of the assessment for Fiscal Year 2018-2019 is the same as the amount of the assessment in Fiscal Year 2017-2018, with no increase.

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SECTION 3. That the City Council does hereby order the work and levy the assessments for the maintenance of specified improvements within the District for that period beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019. Reference is made to the Report for a full and detailed description of the public facilities to be maintained in connection with the District, of the boundaries of the District, and of the amount of the assessments upon assessable lots and parcels of land within the District.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk is hereby ordered to transmit or cause to be transmitted to the Auditor of the County of Ventura said assessments and diagram and plan upon which such levy is based; and the County Tax Collector of said County is hereby designated, requested, empowered, authorized, instructed and directed to enter said assessments upon the County Assessment roll and collect said assessments on behalf of the City of Ojai.


