**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI,
CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE ENGINEER'S REPORT FOR PLAZA
MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 2 PREPARED PURSUANT
TO RESOLUTION 19-03 WITH RESPECT TO THE LEVY AND
COLLECTION OF ASSESSMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH PLAZA
MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 2 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Ojai, California on January 22, 2019 adopted Resolution No. 19-03, in accordance with the provisions of the "Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972" of the State of California (the "Assessment Law"), requiring the City Engineer to make and file with the City Clerk a report in writing presenting certain matters relating to the continuation of a landscaping and lighting maintenance district known as the Plaza Maintenance Assessment District No. 2 in the City; and

WHEREAS, the Assessment Engineer's Report entitled Plaza Maintenance Assessment District Engineer's Report dated April 23, 2019 (the "Report") has been prepared and is on file in the office of the City Clerk and available for public inspection; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has carefully examined and reviewed the Report as filed and desires to approve the Report as filed or modified.

DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**


