**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA  
ALLOCATING THE CITIZEN'S OPTION FOR PUBLIC SAFETY (COPS) REVENUE  
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020**

**WHEREAS**, in 1996 Assembly Bill 3229 established the Citizen's Option for Public Safety (COPS) permanent and ongoing program for frontline law enforcement services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Ojai is eligible to receive funds from the State for law enforcement purposes in the approximate amount of \$100,000 for fiscal year 2019-2020; and

**WHEREAS**, cities are required to appropriate Citizen's Option for Public Safety revenues pursuant to written requests from the Chief of Police; and

**WHEREAS**, Citizen's Option for Public Safety revenues shall supplement existing services and shall not be used to supplant any existing funding for law enforcement services currently being provided; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ojai City Council met on May 14, 2019, to consider requests for use of Citizen's Option for Public Safety Revenue allocations.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Ojai supports the funding allocations for fiscal year 2019-2020 as follows:

Funding for a part-time Sheriffs Service Technician.

Estimated Cost: \$54,600

Funding for the Ojai Police Department's Special Enforcement Program.


Estimated Cost: \$45,400
