RESOLUTION NO. 19- 18

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
OJAI ADOPTING NEW OR REVISED USER AND
REGULATORY FEES AND RATES**

WHEREAS, this action is exempt under California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Article 18, Statutory Exemptions, Section 15273 (a) Rates Tolls Fares and Charges and;

WHEREAS, this hearing to set fees was duly noticed pursuant to Government Code Section 66016, Procedures for Adopting Various Fees.

WHEREAS, the administrative report and its attachments contain a proposed schedule of fees and the estimated cost of providing the corresponding fee-related services.


WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the recommended fees do not exceed the City's costs of providing the services for which the user and regulatory fees and rates are charged.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS;

- A.** The fees incorporated in the attached fee schedule are hereby adopted.
- B.** The adopted fees will be effective July 1, 2019.
- C.** The City Manager is authorized to set any miscellaneous fees and charges not contained in this resolution, not to exceed \$50.00. The City Clerk shall maintain a list of all fees established by the City Manager and shall inform the City Council in writing of each such fee within thirty (30) days after its establishment by the City Manager. City Council approval is required for fees in excess of \$50.00. Fees established by the City Manager will be added to the Master Fee Schedule.
- D.** In the event of a declared local emergency, the City Manager is authorized to waive fees and charges to facilitate recovery. City Council approval shall be sought as soon as is reasonably possible.
- E.** If a portion of this resolution is declared invalid or unconstitutional, then it is the intention of the City Council to have passed the entire Resolution and all its component parts, and all other sections of this Resolution shall remain in full force and effect.
- F.** All resolutions and other actions of the City Council to the extent they establish fees and service charges in conflict with the contents of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
