RESOLUTION NO. 20-16**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI
RECITING THE FACT OF THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION
HELD ON MARCH 3, 2020 DECLARING THE RESULTS
OF BALLOT MEASURE C**

WHEREAS, a duly noticed Special Municipal Election was held in the City of Ojai on March 3, 2020 for the purpose of voting for one (1) ballot measure, Measure C; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No.19-38 the City Council requested the Board of Supervisors of the County of Ventura to consolidate the Special Municipal Election with the Primary Election to be held on the same date pursuant to §10403 of the Elections Code; and

WHEREAS, for a consolidated election, the City Clerk, upon receipt of the results of the election from the County of Ventura Elections Official conducting the election, shall certify the results to the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk finds that the number of votes cast in the City of Ojai at the General Municipal Election is listed on “Exhibit A” to this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Clerk finds that the number of “yes” votes and “no” votes on the ballot measure, Measure C as well as the total votes cast on the ballot measure are set forth in the computer printout from the Ventura County Election Department, attached hereto as “Exhibit A” and incorporated herein by reference.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OJAI, CALIFORNIA,
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION 1. Measure C voted upon at the election is as follows:

Shall the measure to fund capital improvement and other projects by imposing an additional 5% special transient occupancy tax (hotel tax) on hotel guests, expressly confirming the existing “rent” definition as including resort fees, cancellation fees, parking fees, and similar fees, raising approximately \$1,300,000–\$1,700,000 in additional annual revenue to fund City capital improvement and maintenance projects, including street paving; and fire mitigation, code enforcement, and climate change mitigation; until voters decide otherwise, be adopted? SECTION 2. The City Clerk has entered on the records of the City Council a statement of the results of the election, showing the whole number of votes cast in the City, the number of votes given at each precinct and by absentee voters given for and against the ballot measure, as set forth in Exhibit A.

SECTION 3. As a result of the election, a two-thirds majority of the voters voting on Measure C relating to adopting an ordinance imposing an additional 5% special tax on transient occupancy to be used for City capital improvement and maintenance projects, including street paving; and fire mitigation, code enforcement, and climate change mitigation, did vote in favor of it, and that Measure C passed and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

SECTION 4. The City Council hereby declares the Measure C Ordinance as approved by the voters shall take effect ten days after the date the City Council approves this Resolution, and further declares that the Measure C Ordinance's additional 5% special tax on transient occupancy to be used for City capital improvement and maintenance projects, including street paving; and fire mitigation, code enforcement, and climate change mitigation shall take effect on June 1, 2020.


SECTION 5. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk shall attest to the passage of the Measure C Ordinance as approved by the Voters.


